North West 200 Campsite Rules

Campsite Rules, General Responsibilities and Conditions (Vi)

We look forward to welcoming you to Ballymoney Rugby Club NW200 Campsite. The Campsite Committee insists that safety and maintenance of our estate is paramount in its operation. We have drawn up guidelines for everyone's benefit, ensuring that your stay will be pleasurable and at the same time enabling us to continue our work as a rugby club in the safest possible environment.

The Camp Organiser, Johnny Hannah will, at all times will be responsible for our campers and visitors. Our volunteer campsite staff shall not be liable for any loss or damage to property or personal injury sustained whilst on the premises, howsoever caused. The Rugby Club Committee shall not be held liable for refunds in the event of adverse weather conditions or any other reason for visitors terminating their stay on the site early. It is the responsibility of all Campers to ensure that no damage is caused to our beautiful site. Your allocated pitch and the whole campsite should be respected and kept in a clean and orderly condition.

Please show consideration for other campers and our neighbours at all times

Alcohol: Advice from our local council offices and from local Police (PSNI) is that alcohol misuse is our greatest risk. With this in mind, all volunteer staff will be instructed to monitor appropriate use and to report any concerns they may have directly to Ballymoney PSNI station.

Please use and enjoy alcohol sensibly during your stay.

Dogs are not allowed on the campsite at all: If you have visitors please insure this rule is strictly enforced. Guide dogs are the only exception.

All Vehicles: The **5mph speed restriction** must be observed at all times. Vehicles are not allowed onto the campsite pitches even for loading and unloading. Vehicles must park in the designated parking areas.

The busy A26: Please beware of the very busy A26 during your stay. The new Kilraughts roundabout has eased problems considerably but your care and attention are appreciated.

Fires, Trees etc: Fire pits are not to be dug. There should be no fires at all on our estate. No timber may be felled whatsoever or burned on our site.

Gas: all gas appliances are potential hazards. Please use these as directed.

Never use gas inside your tent.

Fire Fighting Equipment: fire extinguishers are available in the clubhouse. Please make yourself familiar with their positions which are clearly marked.

Refuse Disposal: The contents of latrine buckets must be properly disposed of in the designated area.

Please remove all of your rubbish and place it in the bins etc. provided. Please have consideration for our neighbours, our players and wildlife.

Clean cans, bottles, etc can be left for recycling in the containers provided.

Toilet and Shower facilities: these will be operated according to volunteer manpower and our timetable of opening times. This will be clearly displayed.

Toilets: Our clubhouse toilets are clearly marked for male or female use. They will be freshened up regularly but your consideration is requested. There are also temporary toilets distributed around our site. Please remember to leave the toilets as you would wish to find them.

Showers: Our showers are, predominantly, for use by males. We do, however, have one referees' shower which will be designated for use by females.

Site Security: The rugby club gate will be manned at all times. Please have your vehicle passes on display to make everyone's job easier. The gate will be kept locked overnight, only to be opened by our volunteer security staff.

Please keep all your personal property securely under lock and key. Leave nothing valuable in your tent.

Meals and Entertainment

Meals will be provided during set times according to a timetable which will be on display.

Entertainment will be provided after demand etc. have been taken into consideration.

Visitors using our comfortable bar and lounge facilities are required to "sign in" each night so that we comply with local licensing regulations.

NB: Ballymoney Rugby Club reserves the right to ask any camper to vacate the site and make good any damage caused. We thank you, in advance, for your co-operation.

Tent Pegs

Our committee has a commitment to over see the safety of all of our players. We have 180 7-11 year olds, 60 13 – 17 years olds and 110 male/female adults playing rugby at Ballymoney.

Please carry out the following routine during your stay:

1. Count the total number of tent pegs you bring on to our site.
2. Collect them all before you leave.
3. Inform a volunteer if you have lost any and mark the general area where you think they were lost.

We will be arranging for a check of the site before play resumes in August and your help is very much appreciated.
